Entries must be made by July 31 of exhibit year.  
Open to youth enrolled in a 4-H Poultry project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.

**All animals must be in place by 10:00 am on Friday.**

Exhibitors will be responsible for feeding and watering of their own animals.

Pullorum-Typhoid testing will be done on Saturday, August 19, from 9:00 am until 12:00 noon, at the Lamers Farm, Rosner Road, Hilbert (or call 810-1333). Participants must bring their Premise ID number to have their birds tested. Premise ID numbers are available at <http://wiid.org/>.

**Junior Class Poultry Judging will be held on Friday afternoon, following open class, starting with showmanship.**

Cock and hen birds are those hatched before January 1 of the exhibit year. Cockerel and pullet birds are those hatched on or after January 1 of exhibit year.
