DIVISION 470–NATURE SPACE

All specimens must be properly identified and mounted. Specimens are to be collected from Calumet County and displayed in a poster, chart, or scrapbook format that is no larger than 16x24 inches. Insect collections - all specimens must be properly mounted and identified with (1) the insect's common name (scientific name and order is optional); (2) where collected (county and state); (3) date collected.
