RULES AND REGULATIONS

Antiques must be more than 50 years old unless specified.

All exhibits must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.

Articles of a collection, display, or group cannot be entered separately for individual premiums. A collection shall be limited to 3 pieces.

Each exhibitor is responsible for placing exhibitor's tags securely to his/her own exhibit.

No premiums will be awarded any article improperly entered. All articles must be entered in the proper class.

Exhibitors must present claim check corresponding with entry tag when calling for exhibits, and must not remove exhibits without superintendent or assistant being present to check out entries. No article or work previously exhibited at this fair will be accepted for competition until a period of at least three years has passed.

The management reserves the right to determine whether an article is worthy of exhibition. In case an article is in poor condition, but is valuable because of its age or rarity, these factors will be taken into consideration when scoring.

All articles entered for exhibition must be delivered in person.

Every precaution will be taken to insure the safety of exhibits, but in no case will management be responsible for loss or injury to same.

Each exhibitor is limited to one entry per class number.

Entries will be limited to 15 per exhibitor.

No exhibits can be removed before 6:00 pm Labor Day and must be removed no later than 8:00 pm Labor Day.

In preparation of the exhibit, please clean or polish before entering. Some items should not be cleaned or polished as they will lose their value. Those items should stay in their original state.

Please tape covers securely to item.

Exhibits that have won a blue ribbon at a previous Calumet County fair may not be reentered.

OPTIONAL:

Antique furniture that is entered may be used in the cultural arts and crafts areas of displays.
